1. MEMO 4C-3/105

We agree with using pointers for standard but would not like to obsolete STAND 1 and STAND 2 for the moment as long as not all centres can create pointers routinely. NDCC can (and will sometimes) create pointers in an ad hoc way but not routinely.

2. TRANS 9019

a. According to our notes ICANCP0 has been obsoleted (dictionary 3). Is that correct or are we wrong.

b. We had also a new report code INCC- extracted from your update sheets which we could not find back on TRANS 9019.

c. We sent also a listing of data heading tags which we would like to change or to add in case NDS agrees with the scheme given in the letter to Pamela Attree. These modifications are to update the scheme defined at the last 4C-meeting and to move out some omissions, errors and inconsistencies.
