Subject: Entry 10204.

This entry was first transmitted in TRANS 1031 and then revised in TRANS 1042. In the course of this revision it was necessary to split subentry 004 into two subentries, which were assigned the subentry numbers 004 and 005. This would have been perfectly all_right, if this entry had not previously three more subentries 005, 006 and 007, which were then shifted by one subaccession-number to become 006, 007, 008.

The change of the subaccession-number for a given subentry is illegal according to Manual page II.4. It creates a mess in indexing and data-dissemination logs. Furthermore, the change of the subaccession-number was not documented HISTORY so that it took us quite some time to find out what had happened.

The given case could have been solved by "deleting" subentry 004, and adding two subentries at the end with the subentry numbers 008 and 009.

We suggest to keep this entry as transmitted in TRANS 1042, but to avoid such changes of subentry-numbers in future.

Note that the Z number is wrong in the ISO-QUANT of subentry 005.
