Subject: Exfor file "VIENN"

We have started a collection of Various International Evaluated Neutron Nuclear data in Exfor format, called "VIENN". The accession-number will have a V in the first position. Transmission of such data to other centers will be kept strictly separate from normal Exfor transmission. We shall enter in this file important evaluated data which are not available in another computerized format.

The first data sets entered are:

V0001: a Romanian Al-27(n, $\alpha$ ) evaluation

V0002: the Latvian dosimetry file by Lapenas

V0003: Watt spectrum averaged data obtained by Lapenas from his file

We realize that Exfor is not an ideal storage medium for evaluated data, and we regard the entries in this file as temporary. In particular, we suggest that the Latvian dosimetry file should be entered and transmitted in Sokrator format.

We would like to index this data file in Cinda. If no objection arises, we shall do this in the form "EXFOR-V0001.002". If you prefer, however, not to relate the word Exfor with evaluated data, we shall index the data in the form "VIENN-V0001.002".
