

Subject: Publication of CINDA82 Supplement

With regard to the above items I would like to stress a few points which I also raised at the last NRDC meeting (presented as Working Paper 2):

- 1) cutoff date of CINDA coverage; the dates given should be those of the last journal issues or report numbers scanned, not the date of the respective last "Yes" entries. If CINDA readers outside the centres are employed, the information should be sought from them. If you find that a particular series is not worth to be included in the list on pages I.17 and I.18 of the CINDA book, please tell me to delete it.
- 2) Text pages of the CINDA book: It is essential for the timely production of the book that the deadline for changes and additions (4 October) is observed so that the text pages are ready at the same time as the phototypesetting procedure for the CINDA entries. The most frequent delay that occurred in the past was missing expansions of newly introduced lab or ref codes. Please make sure that all new codes which have not yet been made known through 4C- or CP-memos will be sent to me together with their expansions.
- 3) The 10 character conference codes used in EXFOR have to be truncated to 8 characters for CINDA entries. Otherwise the reference field will be messed up at the time of book production.
