After the book deadline we would like to request NEA-DB to convert systematically in the CINDA file all 79JUEL codes to 79JUELIC (possibly including area 1 entries if there are any).

Note = New codes added to this Dictionary should not exceed a length of 8 characters (resp. 2 digits plus 6 letters), due to limitations in CINDA. For longer Conf-codes existing in this dictionary the characters 9 and 10 are dropped in CINDA. The Conf-codes showing up in the CINDA book may differ and must not be used for input.
