CJD agrees to the ID for TRANS being 400000000000 according to the rules for identification (column 67 to 79). This results in ID of 400000000000I (if coming from CJD, Obninsk) which is identical to the ID for NODICTION record.

It is clear for CJD in case of resolved levels. In case of some levels being unresolved, CJD suggests the following description.

Level values are in column arrangement in COMMON DATA section with the left pluses before the every values excluding last value. In DATA section the sum of level contributions into cross sections is presented as a function of an independent variable.
