Subject: 1. coordination of stocking the non-neutron data library "Generalized EXFOR".

2. Additions to Dictionary 27.

1.At the meeting of the Center heads (Paris 1986) I have been charged to coordinate efforts at preparing the data on charge particle nuclear reactions for "Generalized EXFOR" system. I would like to express my views based on the experience gqined.

At the Paris Meeting it was agreed that the list of planned compilations would be sent me by telex and I was to answer also by telex. I have to attract attention to the fact that there are misprints in the communications I have received by telex.

For example, the telex of 14.01.88 from the Brookhaven Laboratory names two different authors of the same paper published in "Inorganic Nuclear Chemistry" v.33, p.3211,1971 and two different numbers have been given to this paper.

I agree that in the case of urgency the telex communication is convenient. But when I receive a list conteining dozens of papers with various types of misprints in their "coordinates" and thus my reply may also contain misprints, the coordination activity becomes of little effectiveness.

In addition, the telex communication is rather expensive. Therefore my suggestion is as follows: when the paper list is not long (as short as 10 papers) to send it by telex, when it is longer- by post.

At this point I am basing on the premise that the letter exchange period would not be too long and all papers could not be compilated for this time.

For example, we have not received yet the RIKEN compilations, though I sent them a telex no later than in 1987,

Also are delayed many compilations from BNL.

It is my feeling that my proposal would permit a number of difficulties to be avoided.
