Subject: Area 2 journal 'Kerntechnik'

- The German journal AKE (Atomkernenergie-Kerntechnik) changed its name to 'Kerntechnik' with effect from Vol.50, No.1 (1987).
- The merger of the 2 former journals Atomkernenergie and Kerntechnik in 1979, was never reflected in dictionary 5; the code KT for Kerntechnik still exists without reference to AKE.
- We propose to NEA-DB to flag AKE as extinct (= still valid for references up to 1986) and to use the existing code KT for new Kerntechnik entries as of Vol.50, No.1 (1987)
- At present, there are only 6 CINDA entries with KT (between Vol.5 (1963) and Vol.17 (1975)) so that no ambiguities between the "old" and "new" journal can occur.
- We will include the proposed change in the next dictionary update unless we receive an objection by NEA-DB.
