Dictionary matters: Duplicate code TEM in dict. 32; conference code 87JURMALA; journal code PDA; lab codes DWU and KHA

1. Duplicate code TEM in dictionary 32 (parameter)

In 1986 the code TEM was introduced for REACTION SF6 to indicate that the data are dependent on the sample temperature (not to be used for SF3=THS= thermal scattering). It was overlooked that the code TEM already existed for NUCLEAR TEMPERATURE. Although it is easy for the human user to distinguish both cases, one of the codes must be changed. Since there is, at present, only 1 subentry in Exfor containing the "new" TEM, namely

12243.005 83-BI-209(N,TOT),,SIG/TEM,

we propose to change this code to TMP. If this is approved at the forthcoming NRDC meeting, NNDC is asked to retransmit this subentry.

2. Conference code 87JURMALA (Memo CP-A/57)

Since new conference codes are restricted to 8 characters (including the year), we enter this conference as 87JURMAL.

Please remember also that we need the exact date (first and last day) of conferences.

3. Proposed journal code PDA (Memo 4C-2/143)

For the publication series "Physik Daten/Physics Data" we introduced, several years ago, a book code in dictionary 7: PH-DAT.

The reason was that it is published like a series of monographs rather than a journal; there are no volume/issue numbers consistent with the usual numbering of journal issues.

The coding PH-DAT was used in several CINDA and EXFOR-V entries.

Therefore PDA is not added to the coming dictionary update.

4. Lab codes DWU and KHA (Memo CP-C/176)
