I like the Quantity/Unit table given in Memo CP-E/040. I suggest that we require a similar table for all future introductions of titles and units. Except that a reference to the article in which the data are presented should be given, since it saves the reader from having to have the data set available. A data set number can also be given if the center sending the memo wishes to include it.

I propose adding the following to our protocol:

When a new quantity or unit is proposed, a table must be given showing either the quantity or unit proposed along with an example of the units or quantity with which it will be used, and a reference to the article in which the data were found.
