Subject: Duplicate lab code CSN

Reference: Memo CP-C/244 of 19 October 1998

The new lab code 1USACSN (California State University, Northridge, California) was proposed in memo CP-C/244 and introduced with dictionary TRANS 9075.

However there is an existing lab code 2FR CSN (Centre de Spectrom.Nucl., Orsay, France). Since for CINDA the last 3 characters of the lab code must be unique, this constitutes an inconsistency.

At the moment we found only one EXFOR entry with 1USACSN (C0092). We propose to change 1USACSN to 1USACFN both in entry C0092 and in dictionary 3.
