Subject: Country codes attached to conference codes

Contrary to other codes, it has always been the practice that the country codes attached to conference codes (only in the Archive and DANIEL dictionaries) represented the country names at the time of the conference, like DDR, USSR Yugoslavia, etc. Probable reasons are that those were the actual names at that time and are printed in the published proceedings. To my knowledge, these country codes are only used for the CINDA books.

I propose to maintain this practice and change back the country codes attached to the Smolenice conferences from currently Slovakia to CSSR, which was valid up to the last one in the dictionary from 1988. Any other such cases should be dealt with in the same way.
